FINANCIAL INSTITUTIONS

We invest directly in financial institutions to scale water and sanitation lending, enabling them to expand microloans and on-lend to households and WSS (water supply and sanitation) businesses delivering water and sanitation products and services.



Household WASH Loans — lending that helps households finance water and sanitation improvements and related services.

WSS Business Financing — lending that supports water and sanitation businesses, including SMEs, to expand their products, services and distribution

CLIMATE-RESILIENT INFRASTRUCTURE

We invest in infrastructure projects and growth-stage companies to support safely managed water and sanitation systems and strengthen climate resilience for vulnerable populations.



Private Equity — growth-stage investments in companies delivering water and sanitation solutions.

Infrastructure Projects — investments into water supply, distribution, treatment, and reuse projects in emerging markets.
